so what is NAI?

Non-accidental injury (NAI) includes injuries that result from deliberate actions against a child or a failure to prevent injury.

RISK factors:

vulnerability of babies

social isolation

financial difficulties

parental mental health difficulties

drug & alcohol use

lack of access to services

What are the factors that increase RISK of non-accidental injury?
