How should Health be responding...







Research shows that your immediate response when someone discloses to you that they have been raped or sexually assaulted can have a powerful effect on their later recovery (Ullman, 2010).









What a FME/CSA medical is..... and what it isn't

Benefits (what it is):

- Evidential (forensics, injury documentation and impact on child)
- Identification of other types of abuse
- Unmet health needs
- Intimate examination is a small part of the assessment
- Can be viewed as a reassurance exam
- Can be offered without police involvement

Myths (what it isn't):

- Compulsory
- Intrusive or traumatic
- Always an "internal"
- Harmful or Painful
- Parent is not with child
- Proof of sexual assault
- Virginity testing

Holistic assessment of all the child's needs at a time when they are vulnerable



What is offered in an FME/CSA medical?



"The swab is not the job"



Trauma informed & hopeful

- Feel safe in that space at that time (calm environment, right people)
- Trust & honesty
- Empowering enable choice and control no matter how small
- Cultural and contextual consideration
- Non-traumatic no repeat questioning, develop shared language
- Allow them to be heard and take it at their pace
- Individual judgement free and seeing the whole person
- Circles of support non-abusing parents and carers, siblings, peers

The health pathway for sexual assault and sexual abuse in Somerset



- Telephone on 0117 342 6999 (24/7) to speak to a paediatrician for advice and in cases of sexual assault less than 7 days ago
- Email strategy meeting invites to <u>TheBridge@UHBW.nhs.uk</u> (checked daily)
- Complete the referral form on our website in cases of non-recent CSA: please ensure you have the young persons/parent/carers consent Referrals - The Bridge - The Bridge
- Once The Bridge receives the referral, we will contact with the referrer and/or the carer/young person to discuss the support we can offer and arrange.
- Contact our dedicated team for non-recent sexual abuse (8 days or more after the incident) <u>Avon River Clinic – The Bridge</u>
